Preamble

The Performance Agreement is entered into between the Prime Minister and Samdrupjongkhar Dzongdag, Samdrupjongkhar Dzongkhag Administration.

The objectives of this Performance Agreement are:

- a) To establish clarity and consensus about annual priorities for the Samdrupjongkhar Dzongkhag Administration consistent with the 11th Five Year Plan , and Governments other priorities;
- b) To make the Samdrupjongkhar Dzongkhag Administration fully responsible for driving implementation and delivering the results against the annual priorities;
- c) To provide an objective and fair basis for evaluating the Dzongkhag's overall performance at the end of the year;

The Performance Agreement represents an important accountability mechanism for inculcating a performance based culture at all levels of government.

THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

Section 1: Vision, Mission and Objectives

A self reliant Dzongkhag co-existing in peace and harmony with enhanced socio-economic standards, rich natural resources and cultural heritage.

Mission

To enhance rural livelihood with good local governance in line with culture and environment.

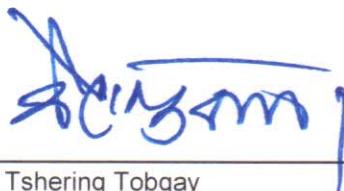
